Straight Ticket Voting

Voters may still vote a “Straight Party Ticket” on their ballot (thanks to a very Liberal Federal Judge) which then selects all candidates from a particular party. There have been rumors though that suggest that such ballots are the easiest to “hack” or change the selection of the voter. We have no way of knowing the validity of such claims but why take the chance. **We recommend choosing Republican candidates in each section of the ballot, whenever possible.**

The Critically Important Non-Partisan Section

The Non-partisan sections will always need your particular attention. **Please make sure to vote the Non-Partisan section of your ballot** for all our judges and school board members, these are very important elections.

Endless Tax Proposals

There will also be a number of tax proposals on your ballot (who would have guessed?). Taxes in every way are already too high for the citizens of this county, it's time our representatives learned to reign in the scope and cost of our local governments. **We recommend a NO vote on every tax proposal.**
